

## Salvation Army Bridge Auckland

The Salvation Army has been providing alcohol and drug treatment programmes in New Zealand since 1907.

We offer residential and out-patient treatment programmes across the North and South Island.

In Auckland, we have Bridge Centres in Auckland Central, Waitakere and Manukau, a respite service in Manurewa, Drug Court services including an intensive day programme, a programme at the Auckland Regional Women's Correctional Facility, (ARWCF), and a regionwide gambling service.

All of our programmes are based on our model of treatment which incorporates the following: a partnership approach, the 12 steps, The Salvation Army core values, and the Community Reinforcement Approach.

All of these services provide placement opportunities for students.
