

Youthline

Youthline works with young people, their families and those supporting young people. Our organisations are made up of volunteer and paid staff members – and we have centres based across the country.

We were established to ensure young people know where to get help and can access support when they need it. At the core of Youthline's work is the development of leadership and personal skills in young people. We do this by involving young people; both those who seek assistance and those who wish to develop themselves.

We have a number of services that are delivered across Auckland from our four centres in Manukau, Central, North Shore and West as well as our free phone counselling service which operates 24/7.

Services include Stand Up! (AOD programme in high schools in CMDHB), Youth Services (Central and North Shore/West), counselling, mentoring, seminars, workshops and training.

▶ PLACEMENTS AVAILABLE

- Two to three Year 1 and 2 undergraduate places, annually
 - One Year 3 undergraduate placement, annually
- Placement duration and role will be discussed on a case by case basis.

30 January for each school year; however applications are welcome throughout the year.

▶ WHAT MIGHT I EXPECT TO LEARN?

Students on placement at Youthline will have the opportunity to work with high school students in either group or individual settings within the Stand Up! programme.

Induction and training is provided, and students will receive group supervision.

Youthline is a youth development organisation and there are opportunities to learn about the other youth work we do.
